AN ACT

To amend the Local Government Act to Provide for Pedestrian Malls

[Assented to 19 July 1979]

RE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

This Act may be cited as the Local Government Act (No. 3) 1979.

Short title

2. The Local Government Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Principal

3. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette.

Commencement

4. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "pave" the following definition:

Definitions

- "'pedestrian mall' means land declared to be a pedestrian mall under section 25A(1) of the Control of Roads Act;".
- 5. Section 349 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (69) the following paragraph:

By-laws

- "(69A) Subject to the terms of any agreement entered into in pursuance of section 25A(3) of the Control of Roads Act in relation to a pedestrian mall -
 - (a) regulating or prohibiting vehicular traffic in;
 - (b) regulating the use, other than access, by any person of,

a pedestrian mall;".
