

# THE NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

## AN ACT

To amend the Electricity Commission Act

[Assented to 10 September 1979]

**B**E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

| 3. This Act shall come into operation on the date of commencement of the <u>Public Service Act (No. 2) 1979</u> .  | Commencement                              |

Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "electrical installation" the following definition:<br><br>"employee" means an employee of the Commission, and includes an employee who is a transferred employee within the meaning of Part VIA of the <u>Public Service Act</u> ;  | Definitions                               |
| 5. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting sub-section (5).  | Northern Territory Electricity Commission |
| 6. Section 14(2) of the Principal Act is amended -<br><br>(a) by omitting from paragraph (za) "and"; and<br><br>(b) by adding at the end thereof the following paragraphs:<br><br>"(zc) to engage such employees as it requires to carry out its functions; and<br><br>(zd) to determine, subject to this Act and to any other law in force in the Northern Territory, terms and conditions (including rates of pay) of service of employees." | Powers of Commission                      |
