THE NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

AN ACT

To amend the Electricity Commission Act

[Assented to 10 September 1979]

B^E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Electricity Commission Act (No. 2) 1979.

Short title

2. The Electricity Commission Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Principal Act

3. This Act shall come into operation on the date of commencement of the Public Service Act (No. 2) 1979.

Commencement

4. Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "electrical installation" the following definition:

Definitions

- "'employee' means an employee of the Commission, and includes an employee who is a transferred employee within the meaning of Part VIA of the <u>Public Service Act;</u>".
- 5. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting sub-section (5).

Northern Territory Electricity Commission

6. Section 14(2) of the Principal Act is amended -

Powers of Commission

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (za) "and"; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following paragraphs:
 - "(zc) to engage such employees as it requires to carry out its functions; and
 - (zd) to determine, subject to this Act and to any other law in force in the Northern Territory, terms and conditions (including rates of pay) of service of employees.".
