# THE NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 37 of 1980

## AN ACT

To further revise and correct the law of the Territory in minor respects

[Assented to 24 April 1980]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

> 1. This Act may be cited as the <u>Statute Law Re</u>vision Act (No. 3) 1979.

2. Sections 42 and 43 of the <u>Abattoirs and</u> <u>Slaughtering Act</u> are amended by omitting from subsection (1)(d) in each section "the <u>Town Planning</u> <u>Ordinance</u>" and substituting "a planning instrument within the meaning of the <u>Planning Act</u>".

3. Section 12 of the <u>Building Act</u> is amended by omitting "Administrator in <u>Council</u>" and substituting "Administrator".

4. Section 19 of the <u>Cemeteries Act</u> is amended by omitting "and Draftsman, <u>Darwin</u>".

5. Section 33 of the <u>Commercial and Private</u> Agents Licensing Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) all words from "A private bailiff" to "of that warrant" inclusive and substituting "Where a warrant is issued to a private bailiff, he is entitled to the fees specified in the Second Schedule to the Local Courts Act in respect of the matters specified in the Schedule"; and
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (2) all words from ", where a private bailiff" to "shall" inclusive and substituting "a private bailiff shall, in respect of a warrant issued to him,".

6. Section 3 of the <u>Companies (Unclaimed Assets</u> and Moneys) Act is repealed.

7. The <u>Criminal Law Consolidation Act</u> of the State of South Australia, in its application to the Territory, is amended by omitting section 2.
