AN ACT

To amend the Poisons Act

[Assented to 14 March 1980]

B^E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Poisons Act 1980.

2. AMENDMENT OF PRINCIPAL ACT

The Poisons Act is amended as set out in the Schedule.

SAVINGS

(1) An appointment or delegation duly made, or other action duly taken or done, before the commencement of this Act under or for the purposes of a provision specified in the Schedule and having effect immediately before the commencement of this Act, is as valid and effectual as if duly made, taken or done under or for the purposes of that provision as amended by this Act, but any action that may be taken or done in respect of an appointment, delegation or action made, taken or done under or for the purposes of that provision as amended by this Act, may be taken or done in respect of that first-mentioned appointment, delegation or action.

(2) Subject to sub-section (3), the amendments made by this Act do not affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under the <u>Poisons Act</u> as in force immediately before the commencement of this Act, or any investigation, legal proceeding, claim, cause of action or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation or liability, and any such investigation, legal proceeding, claim, cause of action or remedy may be availed of, pursued, instituted, continued or enforced as if this Act had not come into operation.

(3) Any action that may be taken or done in respect of a right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under a provision as amended by this Act may be taken or done in respect of a right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under that provision before this Act came into operation.
