An Act to make miscellaneous minor amendments to various laws

[Assented to 19 November 2020]

[Introduced 22 October 2020]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Statute Law Revision Act 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after the day on which the Administrator's assent to this Act is declared.

3 Laws amended

The Schedule amends the laws mentioned in it.

4 Repeal of Act

This Act is repealed on the day after it commences.
