An Act to amend the *Local Government Act 2019* and the *Place Names Act 1967*

> [Assented to 1 March 2024] [Introduced 30 November 2023]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

Part 1 Preliminary matters

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Local Government and Place Names Amendment Act 2024*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after the day on which the Administrator's assent to this Act is declared.

3 Act amended

This Part amends the Local Government Act 2019.

4 Section 274 amended (Substantial temporary road closure)

Section 274(3)

- (3) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply in relation to the following:
 - (a) the closure of a road that is a laneway;
 - (b) the closure of a newly created road that has not yet been opened to the public;
 - (c) a road closure that is urgently necessary in the interests of public safety;
 - (d) any other road closure prescribed by regulation.
