An Act to amend the *Public Information Act 2010* and for related purposes

[Assented to 10 August 2025]
[Introduced 22 May 2025]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

Part 1 Preliminary matters

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Public Information Amendment Act 2025*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after the day on which the Administrator's assent to this Act is declared.

Part 2 Amendment of Public Information Act 2010

3 Act amended

This Part amends the *Public Information Act 2010*.

4 Section 6 amended (Review of public information)**(1) Section 6(1)**

- (1) The Ombudsman may, at any time on the Ombudsman's own initiative or on the written request of an Assembly member, conduct a review of particular public information to determine whether this Act is contravened in relation to the information.

Note for subsection (1)

See section 12 of the Ombudsman Act 2009.

- (1A) If the Ombudsman decides not to review particular public information as requested by an Assembly member, the Ombudsman must notify the member of the decision.

**Part 5 Transitional matters for Public Information
Amendment Act 2025****12 Definitions**

In this Part:

amending Act means the *Public Information Amendment Act 2025*.

commencement means the commencement of the amending Act.

13 Reviews not completed or reports not finalised before commencement to be transferred to Ombudsman

- (1) The following must be dealt with by the Ombudsman in accordance with this Act as in force after the commencement:
- (a) a review under section 6, as in force immediately before the commencement, that is not completed by the Auditor-General before the commencement;
 - (b) a report under section 7, as in force immediately before the commencement, that is not finalised by the Auditor-General before the commencement.
- (2) To avoid doubt, the discretion of the Ombudsman under section 6, as in force after the commencement, to conduct or not to conduct a review, applies to a matter that is to be dealt with by the Ombudsman in accordance with subsection (1)(a).
- (3) As soon as practicable after the commencement, the Auditor-General must transfer to the Ombudsman all documents, materials and evidence in the Auditor-General's possession in relation to the matters to be dealt with by the Ombudsman in accordance with subsection (1).

14 Application of amendments to section 7(3) and (5)

Section 7(3) and (5), as in force immediately before the commencement, continue to apply after the commencement in relation to a report the Auditor-General prepared under section 7 but had not given to the Speaker or Assembly member (as the case requires) before the commencement.
