The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Revision Act (No. 2) 2000.

2. Amendment of Bail Act

Section 15 of the *Bail Act* is amended by omitting paragraph (a) and substituting the following:

- "(a) the period between the making of an order for a separate trial or for the postponement of a trial and the commencement of the separate or postponed trial;".
- 3. Amendments of Northern Territory Employment and Training Authority Act

Section 52 of the Northern Territory Employment and Training Authority Act is amended –

- (a) by inserting in subsection (1) "or refuse to register" before "a training agreement"; and
- (b) by adding at the end the following:

"(3) If the Authority refuses to register a training agreement, the Authority must, in writing, notify the employer who submitted the agreement for registration of the refusal.".

4. Amendments of Northern Territory University Act

- (1) In this section, the *Northern Territory University Act* is referred to as the Principal Act.
 - (2) Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended –
- (a) by inserting in subsection (1) after the definition of "student" the following:
 - "'Training and Further Education Board' means the Training and Further Education Board established under section 24A;"; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (1) the definition of "Vocational Education and Training Board".
- (3) Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraphs (aa) and (c) "vocational education and training" and substituting "training and further education".
 - (4) Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended –
- (a) by omitting from subsection (1)(c) "Vocational Education and Training Board" and substituting "Training and Further Education Board"; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (1)(g) "vocational education and training" and substituting "training and further education".
 - (5) Section 24A of the Principal Act is amended –
- (a) by omitting from subsections (1), (2) and (3) "Vocational Education and Training Board" and substituting "Training and Further Education Board"; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3)(a) "vocational education and training" (twice occurring) and substituting "training and further education".
- (6) Section 27 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (3) "vocational education and training" and substituting "training and further education".
- (7) Section 35 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) "vocational education and training" and substituting "training and further education".

(8) This section is to be taken to have come into operation on 1 January 2001.

5. Amendment of Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act

Section 52A of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* is amended by omitting subsection (1) and substituting the following:

"(1) The Chief Health Officer must appoint a person who is an employee within the meaning of the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act* employed in the Department of Industries and Business to be the Registrar of Pesticides."

6. Amendments of Work Health Act

- (1) Section 3 of the *Work Health Act* is amended by omitting from subsection (8) "*Bushfires Act*" and substituting "*Bushfires Act*, is to be taken to be a worker who is employed by the Territory".
- (2) Section 66 of the *Work Health Act* is amended by omitting from subsection (1) "or (8)" and substituting ", (8) or (8A)".
- (3) The Work Health Act is amended by repealing section 103K and substituting the following:

"103K. Mediation proceedings privileged

- "(1) Except as expressly provided by or under this Act, anything said, written or done in the course of mediation under this Division is not admissible in any other proceedings under this Act.
- "(2) A certificate issued under section 103J(2) is admissible in proceedings under this Act."
- (4) Subsections (1) and (2) are to be taken to have come into operation on 1 May 1996.

7. Repeal

The Acts specified in Schedule 1 are repealed.

8. Revision of other Acts

The Acts specified in Schedule 2 are amended as set out in that Schedule.

9. Revision of Regulations etc.

(1) The By-laws, Regulations and Rules specified in Schedule 3 are amended as set out in that Schedule.

(2) A by-law, regulation or rule amended as set out in Schedule 3 may, respectively, be amended or repealed by a by-law, regulation or rule (as if the amendment had been made by a by-law, regulation or rule).
