to amend the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act*

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Public Sector Employment and Management Amendment Act 2003*.

2. Principal Act

The *Public Sector Employment and Management Act* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

3. Repeal

Section 36 of the Principal Act is repealed.

4. Re-appointment of persons resigning to become candidates at elections

Section 38 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (4) "section 32(6)" and substituting "section 32(7)".

5. Transitional

- (1) Subsection (2) applies to a person –
 - (a) who, immediately before the commencement day, was employed in the Public Sector on a temporary basis under section 36(3) of the Principal Act; and
 - (b) to whom Determination No. 10 applied immediately before the commencement day.

(2) The person is taken to be employed in the Public Sector on a permanent basis but on terms and conditions otherwise that are the same as those on which the person was employed immediately before the commencement day.

- (3) In this section –

"commencement day" means the day on which this Act commences;

"Determination No. 10" means Determination No. 10 of 2002 (Temporary employment for fixed period after reaching retirement age) made under the Principal Act on 19 December 2002.
