# NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

# A BILL for AN ACT

to amend the Criminal Code

**B**E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory* (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

#### 1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Criminal Code Amendment Act (No. 4) 1998.

#### COMMENCEMENT

This Act comes into operation on the date fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

### REPEAL

Section 279 of the Criminal Code is repealed.

## Criminal Code Amendment (No. 4)

#### 4. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Section 323 of the Criminal Code is repealed and the following substituted:

#### "323. CHARGE OF STEALING OR RECEIVING

"Upon an indictment charging a person with -

- (a) stealing any property;
- (b) receiving any property knowing or believing it to have been stolen; or
- (c) stealing any property or, alternatively, receiving the same property knowing or believing it to have been stolen,

the person may be found guilty of -

- (d) stealing the property;
- (e) receiving the property; or
- (f) either stealing or receiving the property.".
