NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

A BILL for AN ACT

to amend the Magistrates Act

B^E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory* (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Magistrates Amendment Act 1998.

2. PRINCIPAL ACT

The ${\it Magistrates\ Act}$ is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

3. APPOINTMENT OF COURTS

Section 13 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) "(1) The Minister" and substituting "The Attorney-General"; and
- (b) by omitting subsections (2) and (3).

4. NEW SECTION

The Principal Act is amended by inserting after section 13 in Part II the following:

"13A. DIRECTIONS BY CHIEF MAGISTRATE

- "(1) The Chief Magistrate -
- (a) must assign and apportion duties to Magistrates and Justices; and
- (b) subject to subsection (2), may give any directions in respect of the performance of those duties as are necessary, including a direction as to the places in the Territory where a Magistrate or Justice is to perform his or her duties.
- "(2) The Chief Magistrate may not give a direction for the purpose of affecting the exercise by a Magistrate or Justice of his or her judicial discretion.
- "(3) A Magistrate or Justice must comply with a direction given by the Chief Magistrate.".

5. FURTHER AMENDMENTS

The Principal Act is amended as set out in the Schedule.
