



AN ACT

to amend legislation consequent on the enactment of the Australian Crime

Commission (Northern Territory) Act

[Assented to 2004] [Second reading 2004]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Australian Crime Commission (Consequential Amendments) Act 2004.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which the Australian Crime Commission (Northern Territory) Act 2004 commences.

3. Amendments of laws

The laws specified in the Schedule are amended as set out in the Schedule.

4. Amendment by subordinate legislation authorised

Subordinate legislation amended by this Act may be amended or repealed by subordinate legislation as if the amendments had been made by subordinate legislation.
