The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Animal Welfare Amendment Act 2004.

2. Principal Act

The Animal Welfare Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

3. Definitions

Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by inserting after the definition of "confine" the following:
 - "'dock', for the tail of an animal, means the amputation of one or more coccygeal vertebrae of the animal;"; and
- (b) by inserting after the definition of "ethics committee" the following:
 - "horse firing' means the application of thermal stimulus to the leg of a horse with the intention of causing tissue damage and the development of scar tissue around tendons and ligaments of the leg;".

Animal Welfare Amendment Act 2004

4. Prohibited procedures

Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1)(a) "unless the animal is a dog less than 5 days old and the docking is performed in accordance with prescribed conditions";
- (b) by omitting from subsection (1)(d) "or";
- (c) by omitting from subsection (1)(e) "pinioning." and substituting "pinioning; or"; and
- (d) by inserting after subsection (1)(e) the following:
 - "(f) engage in horse firing.".

5. Amendment of Regulations

Regulation 3 of the Animal Welfare Regulations is repealed.
