The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Trade Measurement Administration Amendment Act 2002*.

2. Secrecy

Section 19 of the *Trade Measurement Administration Act* is amended by omitting "\$5,000" and substituting "200 penalty units or imprisonment for 12 months".

3. Regulations

Section 20 of the *Trade Measurement Administration Act* is amended –

(a) by inserting after subsection (2) the following:

"(2A) The Regulations may provide for –

(a) the payment of a prescribed amount instead of a penalty that may otherwise be imposed for an offence against the Principal Act or the regulations under the Principal Act or this Act; and

- (b) the service of a notice in respect of payment of a prescribed amount on a person alleged to have committed an offence against the Principal Act or the regulations under the Principal Act or this Act and the particulars to be included in that notice."; and
 - (b) by omitting from subsection (3) "\$2,000" and substituting "100 penalty units".
