AN ACT

to repeal the *Auctioneers Act*

[Assented to 2002]

[Second reading 2002]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Auctioneers Act Repeal Act 2002*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the date fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

3. Repeal

The Acts specified in the Schedule are repealed.

4. Transitional matter

(1) In this section –

"repealed Act" means the *Auctioneers Act* as in force immediately before the commencement of this Act.

(2) A person who immediately before the commencement of this Act held an auctioneer's licence under the repealed Act is, during the period of 12 months after the commencement of a code of practice applicable to

auctioneers prescribed under section 239 of the *Consumer Affairs and Fair Trading Act*, taken to comply with any requirements of that code relating to the eligibility of a person to be an auctioneer.
