The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Parole of Prisoners Amendment Act 2002.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which, but immediately after, the Criminal Code Amendment (Mental Impairment and Unfitness to be Tried) Act 2002 commences.

3. Functions of parole officers

Section 3R of the *Parole of Prisoners Act* is amended by inserting after paragraph (a) the following:

"(aa) to supervise persons made subject to the supervision of a parole officer under a non-custodial supervision order within the meaning of Part IIA of the Criminal Code;".
