The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Parole of Prisoners Amendment Act 2002*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which, but immediately after, the *Criminal Code Amendment (Mental Impairment and Unfitness to be Tried) Act 2002* commences.

3. Functions of parole officers

Section 3R of the *Parole of Prisoners Act* is amended by inserting after paragraph (a) the following:

"(aa) to supervise persons made subject to the supervision of a parole officer under a non-custodial supervision order within the meaning of Part IIA of the Criminal Code;"
