

NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

A BILL for AN ACT

to amend the Juries Act

B^E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory* (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Juries Amendment Act (No. 2) 1996.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act comes into operation on the commencement of the Criminal Code Amendment Act (No. 3) 1996.

RESERVE JURORS IN CRIMINAL CASES

Section 37A of the Juries Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting from subsection (3) "incapable of or";
- (b) by inserting in subsection (3), after "reserve juror", the words ", if any,"; and
- (c) by omitting from subsection (4) "incapable of or" and "incapability,".

Juries Amendment (No. 2)

4. SCHEDULE 7

Schedule 7 to the Juries Act is amended by omitting "any employee referred to in section 11(1) of the Ombudsman (Northern Territory) Act" and substituting "an employee within the meaning of the Public Sector Employment and Management Act who is employed in the Office of the Ombudsman".
