#### The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

#### 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Youth Justice (Consequential Amendments) Act 2005.* 

#### 2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the commencement of the *Youth Justice Act 2005*.

#### 3. Amendment of *Justices Act*

(1) A regulation amended as set out in the Schedule may be amended or repealed by a regulation as if the amendment had been made by a regulation.

(2) A rule amended as set out in the Schedule may be amended or repealed by a rule as if the amendment had been made by a rule.

#### 7. Expiry of Act

This Act expires on the day after it commences.
