- (g) a serious property or vehicle offence (offence D), if the person accused of offence D has, within the period of 2 years immediately preceding the date of the alleged commission of offence D, been convicted of 2 or more of the following offences (each a previous offence), not being offences arising out of the same circumstances:
  - (i) a serious property or vehicle offence;
  - (ii) an offence of attempting to commit a serious property or vehicle offence.

- (3A) In addition to subsection (2), a court may grant bail to a person accused of an offence to which this section applies because of subsection (1)(g) only if the court imposes a condition that the person enter into a conduct agreement containing provisions as mentioned in section 27A(1)(ia) and (ib).

### Division 4 Bail Amendment Act 2016

#### 62 Definitions

In this Division:

amending Act means the Bail Amendment Act 2016.

commencement means the commencement of the amending Act.

#### 63 Application of section 7A

- (1) The amendments to section 7A made by the amending Act apply in relation to the granting of bail to an accused person for an offence if the charge for the offence was filed after the commencement.
- (2) Section 7A, as in force before the commencement, continues to apply in relation to the granting of bail to an accused person for an offence if the charge for the offence was filed on or before the commencement.

#### 7 Expiry of Act

This Act expires on the day after it commences.
