The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Evidence (National Uniform Legislation) Amendment Act 2012*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day fixed by the Administrator by *Gazette* notice.

This Act amends the *Evidence (National Uniform Legislation) Act*.

214 Definitions

In this Chapter:

amending Act means the *Evidence (National Uniform Legislation) Amendment Act 2012*.

commencement day means the day on which section 5 of the amending Act commences.

215 Ongoing proceedings

Despite the amendments made to section 19 by the amending Act, that section continues to apply to a proceeding commenced before the commencement day as if the amendments had not been made.
