NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

A BILL for AN ACT

to amend certain Acts consequential on the making of the Dental Amendment Act 1991

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

5.

This Act may be cited as the Dental (Consequential Amendments) Act 1991.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the Dental Amendment Act 1991.

3. AMENDMENTS

The provisions of the Acts specified in the Schedule are amended as provided for in the Schedule.
