NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

A BILL for AN ACT

to amend certain Acts consequential on the
making of the *Dental Amendment Act 1991*

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Dental (Consequential Amendments) Act 1991*.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the *Dental Amendment Act 1991*.

3. AMENDMENTS

The provisions of the Acts specified in the Schedule are amended as provided for in the Schedule.
