NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

A BILL for AN ACT

to amend the *Remuneration Tribunal Act*

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Remuneration Tribunal Amendment Act 1991*.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

3. POWERS IN RELATION TO MEMBERS OF LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, &c.

Section 9(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act* is amended by omitting paragraph (c) and substituting the following:

"(c) members of the Legislative Assembly (other than the basic salary, within the meaning of section 9A, of such members);".

4. NEW SECTION

The *Remuneration Tribunal Act* is amended by inserting after section 9 the following:

"9A. BASIC SALARY PAYABLE TO MEMBERS OF LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

"Notwithstanding this or any other Act, a member of the Legislative Assembly shall be paid a basic salary at an annual rate equal to the amount of the annual allowance

by way of salary from time to time payable under the law of the Commonwealth to a Member of the House of Representatives who is not entitled to any additional salary, less \$3,000.".
