The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

Part 1 Preliminary matters

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Liquor Legislation Amendment* (Offences) Act 2023.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after the day on which the Administrator's assent to this Act is declared.

This Part amends the Liquor Act 2019.

Division 2A Consumption of liquor at certain public and private places

171A Offence to consume liquor within 2 km of licensed premises

- (1) A person commits an offence if:
 - (a) the person consumes liquor in a public place; and
 - (b) the public place is within 2 km of licensed premises; and
 - (c) the owner or occupier of the public place did not give permission under section 200(1) to the person to consume liquor in the public place.

Maximum penalty: 5 penalty units.

- (2) A person commits an offence if:
 - (a) the person consumes liquor on private premises; and
 - (b) the person is not a lawful occupier of the private premises; and
 - (c) the private premises are within 2 km of licensed premises; and
 - (d) any lawful occupier is absent from the private premises at the time the person consumes the liquor; and
 - (e) a lawful occupier of the private premises did not give permission to the person to consume liquor on the premises.

Maximum penalty: 5 penalty units.

(3) An offence against subsection (1) or (2) is an offence of strict liability.
