1 Citation

These By-laws may be cited as the *Alice Springs (Animal Management) Amendment By-laws 2014*.

These by-laws amend the *Alice Springs (Animal Management) By-laws*.

By-law 113

Omit, substitute

- (1) An authorised person may seize an animal that is apparently:
- (a) diseased;
 - (b) injured;
 - (c) savage;
 - (d) destructive; or
 - (e) stray.

- (2) To avoid doubt, an authorised person may enter upon any land in exercise of the power under clause (1).

Clause 122(1)(a)

Omit, substitute

- (a) that the animal has attacked or injured a person or animal; or

5 By-law 133 amended

Clause 133(4)

Omit, substitute

- (4) The animal must not be released unless the applicable maintenance and release fees are paid together with:
- (a) any fees or costs payable under By-law 138; and
- (b) any outstanding penalties for which the owner of the animal is liable under these By-laws or any other By-laws applying to the municipality.
