#### 1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Environment Protection* (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2011.

#### 2 Regulations amended

These Regulations amend the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Regulations*.

#### 3 Commencement

- (1) Regulation 5 commences on the date of notification of these Regulations in the *Gazette*.
- (2) The remaining provisions of these Regulations commence immediately after the commencement of the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Amendment Regulations* 2011.

#### 4 Regulation 2D amended

- (1) For the definition *approved refund marking* in section 4 of the Act, an approved refund marking for a regulated container is a mark or label that, in accordance with this regulation, clearly and legibly states:
  - (a) "10c refund at collection depots when sold in NT"; or
  - (b) "10c refund at SA/NT collection depots in State/Territory of purchase".

(5) However, for subregulation (1)(a), it is irrelevant if the marking reads "Northern Territory" instead of "NT".

(2) The **prescribed amount** for an infringement notice offence is the amount equal to the monetary value of the number of penalty units specified for the offence in the Schedule.

#### 13 Approved refund marking

(1) For the definition *approved refund marking* in section 4 of the Act, the following approved refund marking under Part 8, Division 2 of the *Environment Protection Act 1993* (SA) for a container is taken to be an approved refund marking for a regulated container of the same type until 31 December 2013:

"10c refund at collection depots when sold in SA".

(2) For subregulation (1), it is irrelevant if the marking reads "South Australia" instead of "SA".
