1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Temporary Exemption for Prohibited Plastic Bags) Regulations*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 September 2011.

3 Temporary exemption for prohibited plastic bags

For section 46 of the Commonwealth Act, the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Act* is, to the extent it relates to prohibited plastic bags, exempt from the operation of the Commonwealth Act.

4 Expiry

These Regulations expire on 31 August 2012.
