Chapter 12 Matters relating to fees

97.01 Form of application for waiver or deferral of fee

An application to the Registrar to waive, defer or permit a party to pay a fee in instalments under regulation 5 of the Regulations must be:

- (a) made in the form approved by the Registrar; and
- (b) accompanied by a written undertaking, given by the applicant, to notify the Registrar of any settlement or judgment in the matter.

97.02 Fee waiver – requirement for certificate of Registrar

- (1) This rule applies if, under regulation 5 of the Regulations, the Registrar waives the payment of a fee by a party to a proceeding.
- (2) Unless the Registrar (or a person acting on behalf of the Registrar) certifies that all fees required to be paid by the party have been paid:
 - (a) a notice of discontinuance of the proceeding by the party must not be accepted for filing; and
 - (b) a judgment or order in relation to the proceeding must not be authenticated.
