Ombudsman Regulations

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Ombudsman Regulations*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of the *Ombudsman Act 2009*.

3 Expenses

- (1) This regulation applies to a person who appears before the Ombudsman for an investigation.
- (2) The person is entitled to be paid the actual expenses reasonably incurred by the person for:
 - (a) travel to and from the place the person is required to appear;
and
 - (b) accommodation and sustenance while the person is required to be absent from his or her usual place of residence.
