1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Marine Amendment Regulations* 2007.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 February 2009.

Part 2 Amendment of Marine (Air Cushioned Vehicles) Regulations

- (f) for an air-cushioned vehicle that is a class 1B, 1C, 2B, 2C, 3B or 3C vessel – an approved Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon having an operation frequency of 406 MHz.

Part 4 Amendment of *Marine (Safety) Regulations*

7 Regulations amended

This Part amends the Marine (Safety) Regulations.

8 Amendment of regulation 5 (Prescribed equipment)

Regulation 5(3) and (4)

omit, substitute

(3) Class 1B, 1C, 2B, 2C, 3B and 3C vessels must carry, in addition to the equipment specified in subregulation (1), an approved Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon having an operation frequency of 406 MHz, and, for the purposes of section 99 of the Act, the beacon constitutes prescribed equipment for those vessels.
