#### 1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Amendment* (Prohibited Persons) Regulations 2008.

### Part 5 Licence conditions

### 14 Persons subject to prohibition relating to purchase of liquor

For section 31A(2)(d) of the Act, the following provisions are prescribed:

- (a) a court order under section 11, 13, 34, 40, 44 or 78K of the Sentencing Act (including the order as varied under that Act);
- (b) an order under section 5 of the *Parole of Prisoners Act* (including the order as varied under that Act).
