1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment (Prescribed Fish) Regulations 2007.

2. Regulations amended

These Regulations amend the Fisheries Regulations.

3. Amendment of regulation 46B (Amateur possession limit)

(1) Regulation 46B(1), definition "fish"

omit, substitute

"fish" does not include the following:

- (a) crustaceans (other than members of the genus *Panulirus*);
- (b) echinoderms;
- (c) cephalopods, which include but are not limited to the species commonly known as squid, octopus and cuttlefish;
- (d) fish prescribed for this paragraph;
- (e) members of the genus *Acanthopagrus*, commonly known as bream;
