1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Residential Tenancies Amendment Regulations 2005*.

2. Principal Regulations amended

These Regulations amend the Residential Tenancies Regulations.

3. New regulation 10A

After regulation 10 -

insert

10A. Prescribed information in notice of intention to terminate tenancy agreement for failing to pay rent

A notice under section 96A of the Act must include the following information, in addition to any other information required by the section:

- (a) the date the obligation to pay rent commenced;
- (b) the current rent payable;
- (c) the frequency that rent is payable;
- (d) the date on which rent was last paid;
- (e) the amount of rent that was last paid;
- (f) the date that rent will be next payable after the breach is remedied.
