**AMENDMENTS OF CORPORATIONS LAW RULES**

**1. Principal Rules**

The Corporations Law Rules are in these Rules referred to as the Principal Rules.

**2. Order substituting plaintiff in application for winding up (Corporations Act s 465B) – Form 10**

Rule 5.10 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting subrule (2)(b) and substituting the following:

"(b) published –

(i) in accordance with rule 2.11 at least 7 days before the date fixed for the hearing of the application; or

(ii) as otherwise directed by the Court."

**3. Schedule 1**

Schedule 1 to the Principal Rules is amended by omitting from Form 1 "*under administration*" and substituting "*administrator appointed*".

**4. Schedule 2**

Schedule 2 to the Principal Rules is amended by omitting paragraph 3 from note 2 and substituting the following:

"3. [*Where the defendant is registered or taken to be registered in a State or Territory other than that of this Registry, state any facts – apart from the defendant's principal place of business – which bear upon jurisdiction being exercised in the State or Territory of this Registry, rather than in another State or Territory.*]
