AMENDMENTS OF CORPORATIONS LAW RULES

1. Principal Rules

The Corporations Law Rules are in these Rules referred to as the Principal Rules.

2. Order substituting plaintiff in application for winding up (Corporations Act s 465B) – Form 10

Rule 5.10 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting subrule (2)(b) and substituting the following:

"(b) published –

(i) in accordance with rule 2.11 at least 7 days before the date fixed for the hearing of the application; or

(ii) as otherwise directed by the Court.".

3. Schedule 1

Schedule 1 to the Principal Rules is amended by omitting from Form 1 "*under administration*" and substituting "*administrator appointed*".

4. Schedule 2

Schedule 2 to the Principal Rules is amended by omitting paragraph 3 from note 2 and substituting the following:

"3. *[Where the defendant is registered or taken to be registered in a State or Territory other than that of this Registry, state any facts – apart from the defendant's principal place of business – which bear upon jurisdiction being exercised in the State or Territory of this Registry, rather than in another State or Territory.]*".
