PART 1 – PRELIMINARY MATTERS

1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Primary Industry*, *Fisheries and Mines Legislation Amendment (Revenue Units) Regulations 2006.*

2. Commencement

(1) Part 3 is taken to have commenced immediately after the commencement of the *Veterinarians Amendment (Fees and Penalties) Act.*

(2) The remaining provisions of these Regulations commence on the day on which these Regulations are notified in the *Gazette*.

a transfer of a 3 letter brand	50
a brand for sheep and swine	100
an earmark for sheep and swine	75

(1) A registered veterinarian must not carry out a prohibited procedure on an animal unless satisfied:

- (a) the procedure is a reasonable and necessary therapeutic measure in the treatment of a disease from which the animal is suffering; or
- (b) if the procedure is not carried out, it will be necessary to induce euthanasia in the animal.
- (2) In this clause:

"prohibited procedure" means a procedure mentioned in section 9(1) of the *Animal Welfare Act.*
