# AMENDMENTS OF PUBLIC HEALTH (SHOPS, EATING HOUSES, BOARDING-HOUSES, HOSTELS AND HOTELS) REGULATIONS

#### 1. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on the commencement of the *Food Act 2004*.

# 2. Principal Regulations

The Public Health (Shops, Eating Houses, Boarding-houses, Hostels and Hotels) Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

#### 3. Citation

Regulation 1 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting "Eating Houses,".

## 4. Regulatory offences

Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting "12, 16(a), 28,".

## 5. Repeal of Part III

Part III of the Principal Regulations is repealed.

# 6. Registration

Regulation 36 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from subregulations (1) and (3) "Schedule 2" and substituting "the Schedule".

## 7. Repeal of Schedule 1

Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is repealed.

#### 8. Schedule 2

Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations is amended –

- (a) by omitting "SCHEDULE 2" and substituting "SCHEDULE"; and
- (b) by omitting from Forms A and B "EATING HOUSES," and "Eating Houses,".
