**AMENDMENTS OF POLICE ADMINISTRATION (FEES)
REGULATIONS**

1. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on the date fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

2. Fee for police attendance at false alarms

Regulation 2A of the Police Administration (Fees) Regulations is amended by omitting from subregulation (1) "\$100" and substituting "\$110".

3. Repeal and substitution

The Schedule to the Police Administration (Fees) Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

FEES FOR PROVISION OF OTHER SERVICES

(a) a member of any rank	\$110 for the first 2 hours or part thereof plus \$28 for each half hour or part thereof after the first 2 hours for each member engaged
(b) a police car or van	61c for each kilometre travelled by each car and van
(c) a police motorcycle	50c for each kilometre travelled by each motorcycle
(d) a police horse	\$22 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each horse
(e) a police motor boat that is –

| 2. Performing special guard duty | \$28 for each half hour or part thereof for each member engaged |
| 3. Providing services in respect of a sporting or entertainment event where duties are carried out by – | |
| (a) a member who holds a rank above the rank of senior sergeant | \$40 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each member of that rank engaged |
| (b) a member who holds the rank of senior sergeant or sergeant | \$33 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each member of that rank engaged |
| (c) a member who holds a rank below the rank of sergeant | \$28 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each member of that rank engaged |
| 4. Providing a support service in respect of a sporting or entertainment event, being – | |
| (a) a police horse | \$22 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each horse |
| (b) a police motorcycle | \$22 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each motorcycle |
| (c) a police car or van | \$22 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each car and van |
| (d) a police motor boat that is – | |
| (i) a single engine motor boat | \$17 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each motor boat of that kind |
| (ii) a twin engine motor boat | \$85 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each motor boat of that kind |

5. Interviewing a member for the purpose of acquiring information about an accident	\$28 for each half hour or part thereof for each member interviewed
6. Providing a report about an accident	\$28, plus 55c for each copy of a page of the report
7. Providing a report about stolen property	\$28, plus 55c for each copy of a page of the report
8. Providing a report for the purpose of granting a passport or visa	\$28 if a search of police fingerprint files is not required and \$66 if a search of police fingerprint files is required
9. Providing photographic services	\$19, plus –
(a) for each black and white photograph, print size –	
(i) 17 cm x 12 cm	\$6.50
(ii) 25 cm x 20 cm	\$12
(iii) 50 cm x 40 cm	\$50
(b) for each coloured photograph, print size –	
(i) 10.4 cm x 15.2 cm	\$1.10
(ii) 20.8 cm x 15.2 cm	\$5.50
(iii) 25 cm x 20 cm	\$11

13.	Providing a report under section 27 of the <i>Prostitution Regulation Act</i>	\$66 for each individual or officer of a body corporate in respect whom enquiries are made and results of enquiries reported
14.	Providing a criminal history report involving –	
	(a) a name check only	\$28
	(b) a name and fingerprint check	\$66
15.	Providing independent forensic services to clients who are not Agencies, being –	
	(a) a general forensic examination	\$110 per hour
	(b) DNA analysis	\$165 per hour
	(c) the preparation of a forensic case file	\$40, plus 55c for each copy of a page of the file
