### Port By-laws

## AMENDMENTS OF PORT BY-LAWS

## 1. Principal By-laws

The Port By-laws are in these By-laws referred to as the Principal By-laws.

### 2. Anchoring near wharf

By-law 5 of the Principal By-laws is amended by omitting "Penalty: \$100.".

## 3. Notice prohibiting use of specific waters

By-law 5A of the Principal By-laws is amended by omitting from clause (2) "Penalty: 20 penalty units.".

## 4. Anchoring

By-law 5B of the Principal By-laws is amended by omitting from clauses (1) and (2) "Penalty: 20 penalty units.".

#### 5. Closed waters

By-law 6 of the Principal By-laws is amended by omitting from clauses (3) and (4) "Penalty: 100 dollars.".

#### 6. Offences

By-law 85 of the Principal By-laws is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) "4AA(3), 4B or 4C" and substituting "4B, 4C, 5, 5A or 5B".
