Minibus Regulations

AMENDMENTS OF MINIBUS REGULATIONS

1. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on the commencement of section 25 of the Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Amendment Act (No. 2) 2003.

2. Principal Regulations

The Minibus Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

3. Definitions

Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after the definition of "driver" the following:

"'minibus rank' includes a bus stop whenever a minibus is parked or standing in the bus stop in accordance with section 38K(1) of the Act;".

4. Touting prohibited

Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after subregulation (1) the following:

"(1A) A person does not commit an offence against subregulation (1) if the person marshals passengers for minibuses at an event or place, and in accordance with conditions, approved by the Director.".

5. Minibus ranks

Regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations is amended by adding at the end the following:

"(e) subject to these Regulations and any code of conduct applicable to minibuses under the Act, the driver of a minibus parked in a minibus rank must not refuse a hiring.".
