

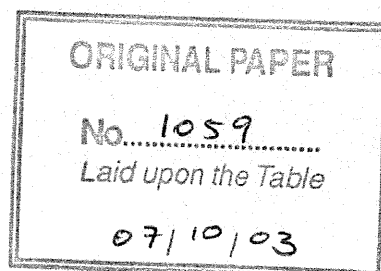

Regulations under the *Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act*

Commercial Passenger (Miscellaneous) Regulations

AMENDMENTS OF COMMERCIAL PASSENGER (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS

1. Commencement

(1) Regulation 4 comes into operation on 1 October 2003 but immediately after regulation 4(2) and (3) of Regulations 2003, No. 44 (Amendments of Commercial Passenger (Miscellaneous) Regulations) commences.

(2) The remaining provisions of these Regulations come into operation on 1 October 2003.

2. Principal Regulations

The Commercial Passenger (Miscellaneous) Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

3. Schedule 1

(1) Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after "**PRIVATE HIRE CAR REGULATIONS**" (first reference) the following:

"34A.	Reg 4(1) or (2)	Failing to make or keep records	100
34B.	Reg 4A(1) or (2)	Failing to maintain a private hire car properly or as specified by Registrar of Motor Vehicles	100".

(2) Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting the following:

"PRIVATE HIRE CAR REGULATIONS

63.	Reg 4	Failing to maintain records	100

(3) Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended by adding at the end the following:

4. Schedule 2

(1) Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting the following:

"Annual fee for grant or renewal of licence for special function vehicle 500".

(2) Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting the following:

"Annual fee for grant or renewal of licence for courtesy vehicle 200".
