## Trade Measurement (Pre-packed Articles) Regulations

## AMENDMENTS OF TRADE MEASUREMENT (PRE-PACKED ARTICLES) REGULATIONS

## 1. Principal Regulations

The Trade Measurement (Pre-packed Articles) Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

# 2. Exemptions from marking requirements (name, address, measurement)

Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after subregulation (2) the following:

"(2A) However, if an exempt package has a name and address or measurement marked on it, the way the name and address or measurement is marked on the package must comply with these Regulations.".

### 3. Unit etc. of measurement to be used

Regulation 14 of the Principal Regulations is amended by adding at the end the following:

## "(4) In this regulation -

'ordinarily sold', of an article sold by number, linear or superficial measurement, means the majority of the merchants selling the article in Australia ordinarily sell it by number, linear or superficial measurement."

#### 4. Schedule 1

Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from item 1 under the heading of food goods "Chaff, maize, oats, potatoes, wheat and other like" and substituting "Any".

### 5. Schedule 3

Schedule 3 to the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting in item 2(a) ", decilitre or centilitre" after "litre".
