AMENDMENTS OF PUBLIC TRUSTEE REGULATIONS

1. Reduction or waiver of commission or fee

Regulation 6 of the Public Trustee Regulations is amended -

- (a) by omitting "accept" and substituting "accept,"; and
- (b) by adding at the end "or waive the commission or fee payable".
- 2. Schedule 1

Schedule 1 to the Public Trustee Regulations is amended by adding at the end the following:

"8.	For inspecting, reporting on and collecting items of personal property of an estate that vests in the Public Trustee upon the death of a person	\$85 per inspection
9. .	For storage of items of personal property of an estate until distributed to beneficiaries or disposed of $-$	
	property taking up a storage area of 5 cubic metres or more	\$6.50 per month per cubic metre or part thereof
	property taking up a storage area of less than 5 cubic metres but more than 1 cubic metre	\$5.50 per month per cubic metre or part thereof
	property taking up a storage area of less than 1 cubic metre	\$4.50 per month".
