Evidence Regulations

AMENDMENT OF EVIDENCE REGULATIONS

1. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 January 2004.

2. New regulation

The Evidence Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 2 the following:

"3. Prescribed qualifications for reporting scientist

"For the definition 'reporting scientist' in section 24 of the Act, each of the following is a prescribed qualification:

- (a) a degree of Bachelor of Molecular Biology awarded by a university in Australia or New Zealand;
- (b) a degree equivalent to a degree mentioned in paragraph (a);
- (c) another science degree that, combined with at least 6 months experience as a forensic scientist at a laboratory, is equivalent to a degree mentioned in paragraph (a) or (b).".
