AMENDMENTS OF MARINE (AIR-CUSHIONED VEHICLES) REGULATIONS

1. Safety equipment

Regulation 16 of the Marine (Air-Cushioned Vehicles) Regulations is amended –

- (a) by omitting "An" and substituting "(1) An";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (d) "item 21; and" and substituting "item 21;";
- (c) by omitting from paragraph (e) "item 22." and substituting "item 22;"; and
- (d) by adding at the end the following:
 - "(f) in the case of an air-cushioned vehicle that is a class 1C, 2C or 3C vessel an approved Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon having an operation frequency of 121.5 MHz and 243 MHz or 406 MHz; and
 - (g) in the case of an air-cushioned vehicle that is a class 1B, 2B or 3B vessel an approved Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon having an operation frequency of 406 MHz.
- "(2) For the purposes of subregulation (1)(f) or (g), 'approved' means approved by
 - (a) the Director; or
 - (b) the Australian Maritime Safety Authority established by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority Act 1990 of the Commonwealth."

2. Offences

Regulation 22 of the Marine (Air-Cushioned Vehicles) Regulations is amended by omitting "\$2,000" and substituting "20 penalty units".
