Electricity Reform (Administration) Regulations

AMENDMENTS OF ELECTRICITY REFORM (ADMINISTRATION) REGULATIONS

1. Classification of customers as contestable customers

Regulation 6 of the Electricity Reform (Administration) Regulations is amended –

- (a) by omitting from subregulation (1) "A contestable customer" and substituting "Subject to this regulation, a contestable customer"; and
- (b) by adding at the end the following:
 - "(4) From 1 April 2005 all customers are contestable customers.".

2. Schedule

The Schedule to the Electricity Reform (Administration) Regulations is amended by adding at the end the following:

1 April 2003		160 megawatt hours per annum	,
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
