Pounds Regulations

POUNDS REGULATIONS

1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Pounds Regulations.

2. Poundage fees

The poundage fees payable in relation to impounded cattle (other than sucklings under the age of 6 months) are set out in the Schedule.

3. Repeal

The Pounds Regulations, Regulations 1967, No. 27, are repealed.

**POUNDAGE FEES PAYABLE IN RESPECT OF IMPOUNDED CATTLE*,
OTHER THAN SUCKLINGS UNDER THE AGE OF 6 MONTHS**

	Fee for the first day or part thereof	Fee for each subsequent day or part thereof
	\$	\$
For an entire horse, mule, ass, camel, bull or boar over or apparently over the age of 2 years	20.00	5.00
For an entire horse, mule, ass, camel, bull or boar under or apparently under the age of 2 years	15.00	2.50
For a mare, gelding, colt, filly, foal, ox, cow, steer, heifer, calf, ram or pig (other than a boar)	10.00	2.50
For a wether, ewe, lamb or goat	5.00	1.25

*Note: "cattle" is defined in section 3 of the Act and includes an entire horse, mare, gelding, colt, filly or foal, bull, cow, ox, steer, heifer or calf, sheep, camel, ass, mule, goat, pig or buffalo.
