AMENDMENT OF LEGAL PRACTITIONERS REGULATIONS

1. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on the commencement of section 32 of the *Legal Practitioners Amendment Act 2000*.

2. New regulation

The Legal Practitioners Regulations are amended by adding at the end the following:

"4. Notice by interstate legal practitioner of commencing to practise

"For the purposes of section 134J(1) of the Act, an interstate legal practitioner must lodge a written notice within 10 working days after commencing to practise in the Territory."
